## Music Note

*When Jesus Came to Jordan* (UMH 252) is one of the only hymns in our hymnal dealing specifically with the Baptism of Jesus. It was written by Fred Pratt Green in 1973 to address the shortage of hymns on this subject. The text is based on accounts of the story in each of the four Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The associated tune COMPLAINER, which predates this text by more than a century, has been attributed to William Walker. The tune name comes from the text with which it was paired in *Southern Harmony*, 1835 – “I am a great complainer, that bears the name of Christ.”
