#### **Music Note**

Clara Schumann (1819-1896), composer of today's Opening Voluntary and Offertory, was a German musician who was considered one of the finest pianists of the Romantic era. Her husband Robert, was the more famous composer but Clara left a substantial body of work, which until recently was largely unrecognized. *The Prelude and Fugue in B-flat Major* dates from 1845. While not expressly written for the organ, it was transcribed for that instrument in 1991.
