Our opening hymn, *Hail the Day That Sees Him Rise* (UMH 312), originally appeared with ten stanzas in *Hymns and Sacred Poems*, 1739 with the title *Hymn for Ascension-Day*. The four stanzas in our hymnal are the original 1, 2, 4, and 5. The hymn as a whole is an elaboration of the accounts of Christ's ascension found in Mark 16:19 and Luke 24:15. The tune Llanfair was written by Robert Williams in 1817. Its name is the anglicized form of "Llanfechell," the composer's hometown in North Wales.
