Monday, June 3

Romans 8:14

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

For Today: Let the Spirit lead you to do something bold today.

Tuesday, June 4

Romans 8:15-16

15 For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" 16 it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

For Today: Remember a child that is not your own but whom you love. Give her/him a little gift or point out something amazing that you have noticed about him/her.

John 14:8-9

For Today: Look around today and try to count the number of times God's creation wows you. I bet you'll lose count!

Prayer: Father, we believe. Help our unbelief. Forgive us Lord for our lack of "vision" to see You in all that your Son did for us.

Thursday, June 6

John 14:11

11 Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; but if you do not, then believe me because of the works themselves.

For Today: Visit someone in the hospital or who is homebound. Take them a little gift.

Prayer: Lord, thank you for the comfort that you bring into our lives by allowing us to comfort and care for others.

Friday, June 7

John 14:13-14

13 I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If in my name you ask me for anything, I will do it.

For Today: Think about times in your life where God has done exactly what you asked.

Prayer: Thank you Lord for Your provisions and oversight. Help our will to always align with Yours.

Saturday, June 8

John 14:15-17a

15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. 17 This is the Spirit of truth.

For Today: Take a moment to "be still." Think about the commandments to which Jesus is referring. Then think about where you might be more obedient.

Prayer: Lord, help each of us see where we are falling short in walking the walk so that Your Holy Spirit might be more audible.

Acts 2:1
